**Subject: Implementation of New 3×15 Scoring System for State Badminton Championships**

Dear All,

This is to inform all affiliated District Associations that the Badminton World Federation (BWF) has approved the implementation of the new **3×15 scoring system** from the year 2027 onwards. Accordingly, the Badminton Association of India (BAI) will implement the same with effect from **July 2026** onwards.

In view of the above, and with the objective of preparing players, coaches, technical officials, and all stakeholders for the proposed transition, it has been decided that all upcoming **State Badminton Championships** in the categories of **Under 11, 13, 15 & 17** shall be conducted using the **3×15 scoring system** with effect from **June 2026** onwards.

**Key Changes Under the 3×15 Scoring System**

- All the Qualifying rounds matches shall be played as **Best of Three Games of 15 Points without setting.**
- Main draw matches shall be played as **Best of Three games of 15 points with extension up to 21 points.**
- If the score becomes **14-all**, the side which gains a **two point lead first**, shall win that game.
- If the score becomes **20-all**, the side scoring the **21st** point shall win that game.
- In the third game, players shall **change ends when a side first scores 8 points.**
- A 60-second mid-game interval shall take place when the leading score reaches eight points.

All affiliated District Associations are requested to take note of the same and ensure necessary arrangements and awareness amongst players, coaches, referees and technical officials for smooth implementation of the new scoring format.
